If you answered “yes,” then join our team! The City of Inman is recruiting a motivated individual to join our Police Department as a Police Officer. Prior experience in policing is not required for the right person.

### **Responsibilities include:**

Patrolling neighborhoods and protecting businesses, citizens, and their property. Responding to calls for service, including calls involving domestic disturbances and juveniles. Enforcing criminal and traffic laws. Providing security for special events including parades, sporting events, festivals, and concerts. Preparing and prosecuting cases in municipal court. Taking incident reports and investigating cases. Being community-oriented and willing to go that extra mile to help the citizens and business owners.

### **Requirements include:**

The successful candidate will be at least 21 years of age and a United States citizen. Possession of a high school diploma or equivalent, along with a SC driver’s license are requirements. The selected candidate must be able to work 12-hour shifts.

Non-certified officers must complete 12 weeks of full-time study at the SC Criminal Justice Academy in Columbia. This training includes firearms, driving, physical agility, defensive tactics, and instruction in enforcing the law. The City pays for all necessary training, including your time at the Academy.

Employment is contingent upon successful completion of a driving and background investigation, drug test, physical and psychological evaluation, and physical agility test.
