MAYOR CORNELIUS HUFF CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER.
FREEDOM OF INFORMATION STATEMENT WAS READ BY MAYOR HUFF CONCERNING
NOTIFICATION OF THIS MEETING.
INVOCATION WAS LED BY COUNCILMEMBER RAY ROGERS, JR.
COUNCILMEMBERS MELVIN FOWLER, RAY ROGERS, JR, KEVIN NEWMAN AND GINGER
MORROW-MCGUIRE WERE PRESENT.
MAYOR HUFF MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA AS WRITTEN, SECOND TO THE
MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

SEWER SUPERINTENDENT JEFF BAILEY PRESENTED THE 2018-2019 BUDGET FOR THE
WASTEWATER DEPARTMENT AND IS PROPOSING A 5% INCREASE IN SEWER RATES;
REPLACING A PICKUP TRUCK THAT HAS OVER 100,000 MILES; AND INCREASING THE
TRAINING LINE ITEM.

CITY ADMINISTRATOR JEREMY CAUDLE PRESENTED THE 2018-2019 BUDGET FOR THE
HOSPITALITY TAX FUND AND DISCUSSED INCREASES IN LINE ITEMS FOR THE 'LIGHT UP
INMAN' & "BOO ON MILL" EVENTS AND PURCHASING CHRISTMAS LIGHTS.
MR. CAUDLE ALSO REPORTED THAT FOR THE GENERAL FUND THAT HE IS PROPOSING A
MILLAGE RATE INCREASE TO 76.15 MILLS ON THE ASSESSED VALUE OF ALL REAL AND
PERSONAL PROPERTY OF WHICH 10.00 MILLS WILL BE USED TO MAINTAIN THE RESERVE
ACCOUNT.
