REGULAR MEETING  
NOVEMBER 11, 2019

MAYOR CORNELIUS HUFF CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER.

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION STATEMENT WAS READ BY MAYOR HUFF CONCERNING NOTIFICATION OF THIS MEETING.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE WAS LED BY INMAN POLICE CHAPLAIN BILL HOLLAND.

COUNCILMEMBERS KEVIN NEWMAN, GINGER MORROW-MCGUIRE AND RAY ROGERS, JR. WERE PRESENT. COUNCILMEMBER MELVIN FOWLER WAS ABSENT DUE TO ATTENDING ANOTHER EVENT.

COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER MORROW-MCGUIRE, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

IN RECOGNITION OF VETERANS DAY MAYOR HUFF RECOGNIZED THE VETERANS THAT WERE IN THE ROOM ATTENDING THE MEETING AND THANKED THEM FOR THEIR SERVICE.

MAYOR'S YOUTH COUNCIL PRESIDENT ANNA SPEARS REPORTED THAT THEY HAD THE OCTOBER MOVIE NIGHT AT THE MABRY MIDDLE SCHOOL GYM DUE TO THE WEATHER AND THEY HAD ABOUT 50 PEOPLE AND THEY THANKED EVERYONE FOR THEIR HELP. VICE PRESIDENT ALEXIS YODER REPORTED THAT THEY WILL BE HELPING WITH THE INMAN CHRISTMAS PARADE AND LIGHT UP INMAN BUT IF CHAPMAN HIGH FOOTBALL TEAM GOES TO STATE THAT THEY WILL GET OTHER VOLUNTEERS FROM THE OTHER SCHOOL ORGANIZATIONS TO HELP.

COUNCILMEMBER MORROW-MCGUIRE MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE OCTOBER 14, 2019 REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER ROGERS, JR., MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

POLICE CHIEF KEITH TUCKER REPORTED 22 CRIMINAL, 39 TRAFFIC AND 13 ACCIDENTS TOTALLING \$46,050 IN DAMAGES FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 2019.

POLICE CHIEF KEITH TUCKER WAS ABSENT DUE TO ATTENDING THE S.C. POLICE CHIEFS CONFERENCE IN MYRTLE BEACH SO CITY ADMINISTRATOR MISSY HOUSE REPORTED THAT THE POLICE DEPARTMENT WILL BE TEAMING UP WITH IRON POWER SPORTS ON HWY 292, HOLDENS MARINE AND FIRST FRANKLIN FINANCIAL IN BOILING SPRINGS TO COLLECT COATS FOR THE HOMELESS. SHE STATED THAT THEY WILL HAVE A LIVE BROADCAST ON THE NEWS ON NOVEMBER 18 AT IRON POWER SPORTS AND THEY ARE PROVIDING 2 U-HAUL TRUCKS FOR FREE SO THEY WILL BE TAKING DONATIONS NEXT MONDAY THRU THURSDAY AND WILL BE TAKING THE COATS TO SPARTANBURG ON THURSDAY. SHE ALSO REPORTED THAT THE 5K SANTA RUN WILL BE HELD ON DECEMBER 7, 2019 AND WILL BE TAKING DONATIONS OF TOYS UP UNTIL CHRISTMAS EVE, DECEMBER 24, 2019.

FIRE CHIEF CHRIS COTHRAN REPORTED RESPONDING TO 21 CALLS FOR THE PERIOD OF 10/14/19 THRU 11/11/19 WITH MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS WITH THE MOST CALLS. HE REMINDED EVERYONE WITH THE COLD WEATHER TO BE CAREFUL WITH HEATERS AND REPORTED THAT THE "BOO ON MILL" INSIDE AT INMAN FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH GYM DUE TO THE WEATHER TURNED OUT WELL.

SEWER SUPERINTENDENT JEFF BAILEY REPORTED THE TOP TEN WORK HISTORY SUMMARY REPORT FOR THE PERIOD OF 10/09/19 THRU 11/07/19 WITH THE BELT PRESS, HYCOR SCREEN AND SAMPLING WITH THE MOST HOURS. MR. LONNIE MATHIS WAS PRESENT AND STATED THAT THE CDBG PROJECT ON BOBO AND BOMAR STREETS WILL GO TO SC DHEC THIS WEEK FOR PERMITTING.

STREET SUPERVISOR HEATH FOWLER REPORTED FINISHING UP GRASS CUTTING, TRIMMING HEDGES, CLEANING OUT AND REPAIRING THINGS IN THE ARMORY AND STARTING TO GET CHRISTMAS DECORATIONS UP.

PLANNING COMMISSION CHAIRMAN PETE MILLER REPORTED THAT THEY SPENT THE LAST MEETING LOOKING AT THE CBD, CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT BUT THEY WERE UNABLE TO BRING RECOMMENDATIONS TO COUNCIL TONIGHT BUT THEY SHOULD BE ABLE TO BY NEXT MEETING.

CITY ADMINISTRATOR MISSY HOUSE REPORTED THAT A CONTRACT WITH CC&I SHOULD BE SIGNED IN A WEEK OR SO FOR PERMITS, INSPECTIONS, AND CODE ENFORCEMENT SERVICES, RECEIVED BOUNDARY SURVEYS FOR THE FARMERS MARKET PROJECT AND SHE SUBMITTED AN APPLICATION FOR THE MASC HOMETOWN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GRANT AND WAS AWARDED THE MAXIMUM OF \$25,000 WHICH WILL GO TOWARDS THIS PROJECT, LEAF PICKUP WILL BE HANDLED BY WASTE INDUSTRIES SO ALL LEAVES WILL HAVE TO BE BAGGED AND THE DATE FOR PICKUP IS SATURDAY, DECEMBER 14, 2019 AND SHE WILL BE ATTENDING THE LOCAL LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE THIS WEEK.

COUNCILMEMBER ROGERS, JR. MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE NO. 2019-27, AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE A 100 PERCENT ANNEXATION PETITION AND TO APPLY A ZONING DESIGNATION TO THE ANNEXED PROPERTY OF TAX MAP# 1-44-06-224.00, ASHEVILLE HWY, INMAN & TAX MAP# 1-44-06-231.00, PINE ST., INMAN, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

COUNCILMEMBER MORROW-MCGUIRE MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE RESOLUTION NO. 2019-28, A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE DAY AFTER THANKSGIVING AND CHRISTMAS EVE 2019 AS HOLIDAYS FOR THE CITY OF INMAN EMPLOYEES, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE NO. 2019-29, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF INMAN CURRENT BUSINESS LICENSE ORDINANCES AND ESTABLISHING FEES AND A BUSINESS CERTIFICATION SYSTEM, SECOND

TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER ROGERS, JR., MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

COUNCILMEMBER MORROW-MCGUIRE MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE NO. 2019-30, AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY OF INMAN CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 12, SECTION 12-7 TIME FOR ASSUMING OFFICE, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

MAYOR HUFF MADE A MOTION TO TABLE DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON HOSPITALITY TAX GRANT APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE GREATER INMAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

UNDER COUNCIL TIME:
