PUBLIC HEARING ON ZONING AMENDMENTS

MAYOR CORNELIUS HUFF OPENED THE PUBLIC HEARING AND WELCOMED EVERYONE.

COUNCILMEMBERS MELVIN FOWLER, KEVIN NEWMAN, AND GINGER MORROW-MCGUIRE WERE PRESENT. COUNCILMEMBER RAY ROGERS, JR. WAS ABSENT.

MAYOR HUFF READ THE PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE FOR THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS: ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT NO. 2018-05, "AN AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT FLAG LOTS AND SHARED DRIVEWAY IN RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICTS"; ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT NO. 2018-06, "AN AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT MOBILE HOMES, TRAILERS, AND MANUFACTURED HOMES IN CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICTS"; AND ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 2018-07, "AN AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 817 "MOBILE HOME STANDARDS."

PROPERTY OWNER MS. ETHEL BLANTON QUESTIONED IF HER TRAILER ON FLEETWOOD STREET WOULD HAVE TO BE MOVED. MAYOR HUFF STATED TO HER THAT IF HER TRAILER BECOMES DELAPIDATED OR CATCHES ON FIRE THEN SHE WILL HAVE TO BUILD BUT SHE IS CURRENTLY GRANDFATHERED IN.
