

**INMAN CITY COUNCIL
BUDGET WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES
WEDNESDAY, MAY 29, 2019
INMAN SEWER DEPARTMENT CONFERENCE ROOM**

The City of Inman City Council held a budget workshop on Wednesday, May 29, 2019 at the Inman Sewer Department's Conference Room, 1350 Campton Road, Inman, SC at 5:03 PM. Mayor Huff and Mayor Pro-Tem Melvin Fowler were present, along with Councilmembers Kevin Newman and Ray Rogers. Also in attendance was City Administrator Missy House. Councilmember Ginger Morrow-McGuire arrived a few minutes after the start of the meeting.

Mayor Huff called the meeting to order and read the Freedom of Information Act statement concerning notification of this meeting.

Mayor Por-Tem Fowler offered the invocation.

Councilman Newman made a motion to approve the agenda. Second to the motion was made by Mayor Pro-Tem Fowler. Motion carried with all voting.

Mayor Huff welcomed the group and introduced City Administrator, Missy House, to take the lead in the discussion. Ms. House started by hitting the highlighted changes from the last time Council met to go over the budget. The changes include increased insurance prices and an increase in the assessed value of property in the city limits. With the increased assessed value, Ms. House explained that there would be more tax revenue for the next fiscal year.

Ms. House opened up the discussion to the council to discuss how to utilize those added funds, as well as, make changes to the recommended budget as they choose. There was lengthy discussion around the table and possible changes to the general fund and sewer funds were contemplated.
