MAYOR CORNELIUS HUFF CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER.

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION STATEMENT WAS READ BY MAYOR HUFF CONCERNING NOTIFICATION OF THIS MEETING.

INVOCATION WAS GIVEN BY COUNCILMEMBER RAY ROGERS, JR.

COUNCILMEMBERS MELVIN FOWLER, RAY ROGERS, JR., AND GINGER MORROW-MCGUIRE WERE PRESENT.

COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER ROGERS, JR., MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

CITY ADMINISTRATOR MISSY HOUSE PRESENTED THE 2019-2020 GENERAL FUND BUDGET REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES AND DISCUSSED THE HIGHLIGHTS OF FULL YEAR FIRE SERVICE, CONTINUING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, AND CHRISTMAS BONUS FOR EMPLOYEES.

SEWER SUPERINTENDENT JEFF BAILEY PRESENTED THE BUDGET FOR THE SEWER DEPARTMENT WITH INCREASES IN TRAVEL, PURCHASE OF NEW TRUCK AND AN INCREASE IN CHEMICALS DUE TO MORE SUBDIVISIONS.

STREET SUPERVISOR HEATH FOWLER PRESENTED THE BUDGET REQUESTS FOR THE GENERAL FUND STREET DEPARTMENT WITH THE EQUIPMENT REPAIR TO STAY THE SAME AS LAST YEAR AND WILL NEED TO ADD A LINE ITEM FOR INSURANCE ON THE CITY PARKS.

FIRE CHIEF CHRIS COTHRAN PRESENTED THE BUDGET REQUESTS FOR THE GENERAL FUND FIRE DEPARTMENT AND STATED THAT HE IS SATISFIED WITH THE AMOUNT THAT IS BUDGETED FOR FULL YEAR FIRE SERVICE AND WILL BE PURCHASING TURN OUT GEAR.

POLICE CHIEF KEITH TUCKER WAS AWAY AT A CONFERENCE SO CITY ADMINISTRATOR MISSY HOUSE PRESENTED THE GENERAL FUND POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET REQUESTS.
